The Easter Village is a non-governmental organization. The residential care facility program is licensed and accredited by the DSWD, the Foster Care and Independent Living are also licensed by the DSWD. Our facility caters to children who are surrendered, foundling, abandoned, orphaned and neglected by their own parents and relatives.

VISION

We envision children admitted into care with a secure and productive life, deeply rooted in Christian values and at peace with themselves and with their wider community.

MISSION

To provide shelter, protection, care and formation for the abandoned and neglected children without primary caregivers, enabling them to regain the damaged self and resolve negative feelings of anger and hopelessness as a result of poverty, neglect and violence developing their potentials and improving their ability to succeed in life and thus becoming effective promoters of social justice and peace.

GOALS

To operate and maintain residential care program which will provide for the basic needs of the children enabling them to survive and have a productive life.

To develop and implement development programs for basic education, skills training, values formation, moral and spiritual enrichment based on Christ-centered principles and doctrines.

To foster an environment of respect for different cultures.

To implement programs for alternative placement for children who cannot be reunited with their biological parents/kins.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITY



Easter Village is temporary in nature and therefore admits child/ren in the home for an agreed period of time. Custody can only be extended when necessary. In most cases, parents or guardian are encouraged to take the responsibility in caring for their own children. Easter Village Home is considered as the last recourse after all efforts have been exhausted. It should not accommodate more than the maximum capacity of children in the home. Otherwise quality care and services will not be given to the children. The programs and services designed primarily to ensure Christian training and nurturing of the children. These services ensure meeting and satisfying the welfare and needs of the children while in the care of the agency.

FOSTER CARE



Regular Foster Care – the placement of an unrelated abandoned, neglected or dependent child with normal development, regardless of age, to a licensed foster family.



Kinship Care – the placement of a child to his/her relatives or godparents who have been licensed.

Foster Family Care for children with Special Needs - Children whose adoption has been disrupted and need temporary placement.

INDEPENDENT LIVING



This service will be provided to older children to ensure a successful transition to adulthood.
